#### James River Canoe Trek

- Partnership with Twin River Outfitters
  - Buchanan, VA
- 61+ miles of canoeing adventure (From the Iron Gate to Snowden Dam)
- Over 100 class I rapids, and 20 challenging class II rapid
  - Including infamous Balcony Falls rapid
- Camping at public campgrounds along the way

#### James River Canoe Trek – Itinerary Update

- Thursday
  - 3:00 pm: TRO staff will swap out canoes for kayaks
  - TRO will shuttle drivers back to Buchanan so your unit will have their cars at Wilderness Canoe Campground.
    - This will allow you to pack cars with gear, eliminating the need to carry gear on Friday and speed up your departure.

#### • Friday

- 8:30 am: pack camping gear into your vehicles and stage vehicles in parking areas.
- Launch by around 9 am, for a 1 PM pickup at Snowden Take Out.
- Drive back to Wilderness Canoe Campground & depart for Lenhok'sin High Adventure.
- Return to Lenhok'sin High Adventure (Camp Baird Base Camp).

#### What is High Adventure?

- Multi-day excursions in a remote location
- Usually change camp sites from day to day
- More challenging environments
- Pack much lighter since you carry everything
- Either inside the BSA "Safety Net" or "DIY"

#### Ways to Go on a High Adventure Trek

- With your Unit
- Through Council-run Contingent Crews
- As an Individual (including OA crews)

### **High Adventure w/Council Crews**

- *Many units* lack the "critical mass" to conduct their own trek:
  - Not enough age-appropriate Scouts in Unit
  - Lack of Adult Leader HA experience & knowledge
- Consider NCAC HAC "Contingent" / "Provisional" treks:
  - Accept small groups or individuals from these Units
  - Unit crews "leave the nest" after one or more HAC treks
- NCAC HAC handles all planning & logistics plus ...

### **Council Crews, continued**

- NCAC HAC offers Training Sessions for
  - Philmont
  - Northern Tier
  - Sea Base
- Philmont Adult Advisor Hike (mandatory for HAC treks)
- Adult Advisors & Crew Leaders <u>from any NCAC crew</u> are always welcome at any NCAC HAC training or to tap into our decades of HA experience!
