

# Goshen Scout Reservation 2024 Adult Leader Training Opportunities

Goshen Scout Reservation is proud to partner with the NCAC Training Committee to offer training opportunities to Adult Leadership during the summer while in attendance at a GSR Camp. Adult Leader trainings are available to all registered adults, no matter which camp at the Goshen Scout Reservation you are attending. Registration will occur via Blackpug.

## Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation (BALOO)

BALOO is the Cub Scout leader training required for any Cub Scout den or pack outdoor event, including pack camping overnights and Webelos/Arrow of Light den overnights.

## Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills (IOLS)

The IOLS course builds and expands on the concepts and themes introduced in Scoutmaster Position-Specific Training and provides Scouters with the confidence to take youth into the outdoors.

## Scoutmaster Position-Specific Training

Scoutmaster-Specific Training introduces adult leaders to everything they need to know about running a Scouts BSA Troop, including how to be a mentor so youth may learn and practice leadership. While this training will not answer every single question you have, it is a great start! This course, combined with Youth Protection Training and the IOLS course, will make you an “fully trained” Scouts BSA leader.

## Citizenship in Society Merit Badge Counselor Training

Citizenship in Society is the Boy Scouts of America’s newest merit badge for youth in the Scouts BSA program and is an Eagle required merit badge (one that is required for the rank of Eagle Scout starting July 1, 2022). To become a counselor for this merit badge, an adult volunteer must complete a series of online and in person trainings. This training fulfills the in-person NCAC Citizenship in Society Merit Badge Counselor Training requirement.

## Life to Eagle Conference

The Seminar is focused on Life Scouts or advanced Star Scouts who want to pursue the Eagle Rank. It also is useful for Eagle advisers, coaches or unit leaders who haven't attended a seminar in the last two years. Parents of Scouts working on the Eagle Rank or other adults interested in Scouting can also benefit from attending the seminar.
