Osprey 2026 Schedule

What is Osprey?

The Osprey program is Goshen Scout Reservation's dedicated program experience for "older Scouts." Osprey is an introductory high adventure experience that explores activities all around Goshen Scout Reservation. This program is available to all Scouts BSA youth attending Camps Olmsted, Marriott, and Bowman, and is primarily based out of Camp Marriott. Participants are recommended to be at least 14 years old.

Program Details:

The Osprey schedule offers a balanced mix of skill-building, adventure, and relaxation for Scouts. Over the course of the week, Scouts will participate in a variety of activities, including team-building challenges at COPE (Challenging Outdoor Personal Experience), circumnavigating 450-acre Lake Merriweather by canoe, a metal working workshop, hike to "Jump Rock," and so much more. Activity and Transportation Specifics:

Osprey is a full day (9:00 am – 5:00 pm), full week (Monday – Friday) program based out of Camp Marriott at Goshen Scout Reservation. Adult leaders should plan to transport participating Scouts to Camp Marriott for each day of program, except for Monday. Monday morning program will occur at the Camp Post COPE Pavillion. Tuesday – Thursday lunch and siesta (12:00 pm – 2:00 pm) will be based out of Camp Marriott. Scouts should plan to return to their "base camp" for lunch and siesta on Monday and Friday, per the schedule above.

Please refer to the program schedule above for meeting locations each morning. Scouts will be greeted by the Osprey staff each morning and afternoon for check-in prior to the start of program. When traveling to Osprey, please consider the travel time between your base camp and meeting location. Please speak with your camp's administrative team should you have questions about transportation and travel time.

Scouts should bring water bottles and comfortable, appropriate, closed toed-footwear, and clothing appropriate for the activities of the day.
