Campsite Inspection Guidelines:

Litter: No litter in and around tents and common area.

Tents: No lines on trees lower than 6 feet, floors swept clean, gear stored neatly and safely

Latrine and Sink: Seats are clean, floor swept, lids down, no litter in area, faucets turned off when not in use.

Fireguard: Fire chart is posted and updated, fire barrel is full, no unattended fires in campsite.

Safety: Safe conduct in camp and in campsite.
